Hot Ashes and Charcoal Disposal

One common cause for fires in trucks and containers is hot coals and ashes. Coals can appear to be cool and actually remain hot for days after use. Please allow 48 to 72 hours for charcoal and ashes to cool down before disposing of them in the trash container.

It's Easy Being Green... (a few tips)

Here are some simple suggestions to save water and energy... and money!

- Vacuum your forced air system filter so it doesn't have to work as hard to pull the air through it.
- Test your doors for leaks. Go outside in the dark and check for light shining through.
- Vacuum your refrigerator coils. Check the gasket seals by closing a piece of paper in the door. If you can move it up and down easily, the gaskets are not sealing well, and warm air is leaking in.
- Unplug or recycle extra refrigerators. Older and second units may use as much as 40% more energy than newer models.
- Keep the dryer lint trap and the exhaust vent clean so the dryer doesn't have to work as hard. In fact, a dirty lint trap will slow down the drying process.
- Use the air-dry mode in your dishwasher.

Proper Disposal of Household Hazardous Waste

Many households generate hazardous waste that is dangerous or illegal to dispose of in the trash and can also be harmful to the environment. Here is a list of the following items that are considered hazardous waste and should be disposed at a HHW location:

- Batteries or car batteries
- Cleaners
- · CRTs, old TVs, misc. electronics
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- · Mercury thermometers or thermostats
- Motor oil, oil filters, brake fluid
- · Paint, paint thinner, turpentine
- · Pesticides or herbicides
- · Pool chemicals
- Unwanted or expired prescriptions
- Used antifreeze
- Used needles or sharps (In a Sharps container or sturdy box labeled "SHARPS")

Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your containers in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. Barrels should have the handles facing towards your home. Barrels should be placed one foot apart from each other. The barrels need to be placed at least three feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox or vehicle.

All barrels must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.



Temporary Containers for Special Clean-Ups Available

Burrtec offers large and small containers for residential clean-ups and special projects. Containers are available for seven-day rentals and include delivery and removal. All unwanted materials can be placed directly into the container with the exception of hazardous waste, tires or large amounts of dirt, rock, concrete or asphalt.
