### The Holidays Are Soon Approaching

Approximately 80% of your holiday trash is recyclable. All boxes, wrapping paper, greeting cards and cardboard packaging are items that may be placed in your recycling barrel. Burrtec will collect your excess holiday trash and recyclables. Beginning the day after Christmas for approximately one week, place excess holiday trash/ recyclables in bags alongside your containers on your collection day.



#### **Christmas Tree Recycling**

Burrtec will collect and recycle natural Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at the curbside after Christmas Day on your designated collection day. This service will be available from December 26th to January 16th. If your tree is six feet tall or more, please cut it in half. Ensure that all ornaments, lights, and stands are removed from the tree before placing it out for collection.

Please note that flocked trees are not recyclable and will be collected as trash. If you have a flocked tree that is six feet tall or more, please also cut it in half to facilitate disposal. Thank you!



All barrels must be curbside by 6AM on your service day.

#### Temporary Containers for Special Clean-Ups Available

Burrtec offers large and small containers for residential clean-ups and special projects. Containers are available for seven-day rentals and include delivery and removal. All unwanted materials can be placed directly into the container with the exception of hazardous waste, tires or large amounts of dirt, rock, concrete or asphalt. #### **Bulky Item Pick-Up**

Are you replacing an old sofa, water heater or refrigerator and don't know what to do with it? We'll take care of it. Residents can request up to two curbside collections of large or bulky items during a calendar year. Limit of five items per collection. This program also includes electronic waste. This program is at no additional cost and designed for your convenience. Please call our Customer Service Department one week prior to your scheduled collection day to arrange pick-up. This collection does not include concrete, rock, dirt or construction/ demolition materials.



#### Winter Storm Weather

Storms with heavy rainfall may cause debris flows and many other issues in our streets. In order to prevent trash and recycling barrels from adding to the issue, please consider the following guidelines:

- Be aware of storm and windy weather forecasts. 1.
- Be aware of potential storm water flows in and around your property. 2.
- Avoid placing barrels and bulky items where flows can create hazards. In swift 3. moving waters, these items can float and rush out into the street.
- 4. Please place trash and recyclables in bags prior to throwing them in barrels. This will minimize spillage onto city streets.

#### **Horse Manure Disposal**
