What happens after June 30, 2028?

The City granted a new hauler an Exclusive Franchise Agreement for Commercial Solid Waste, Garbage, Recyclable Material, and Organic Waste Collection Services. They will be the City's only solid waste service provider starting July 1, 2028.

Holiday Schedule

Please note that services are interrupted on the following holidays:

Memorial Day		Independence Day		Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day		Christmas Day		New Year's Day

When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

State Required Contamination Monitoring of Recyclables

California state law SB 1383 requires jurisdictions to monitor trash, recycling, and organics barrels to minimize contamination. Trash and other contaminants in the recycling or organics collection container(s) could result in a fee and non-collection due to contamination. If contamination is found, contamination tags (as shown to the right) will be affixed to the container lid. After the first notice, customers may be charged a contamination fee and the container will not be serviced as recyclable; it will be subsequently serviced as trash. Please note: the contamination fee will be automatically assessed if hazardous or bio-hazardous materials are placed in any collection container. Not sure about what goes in each container? TRASH RECYCLABLES FOOD WASTE GREEN WASTE

We found the following contamination:

1. **Trash**
Such as animal waste, plastic bags, wrappers, diapers
→ GRAY/BLACK CONTAINER ONLY

2. **Recyclables**
Rigid plastics, glass, metal, paper and cardboard
→ BLUE CONTAINER ONLY

3. **Food Waste**
Includes food soiled paper
→ BROWN CONTAINER ONLY

4. **Green Waste**
Must be unbagged
→ GREEN CONTAINER ONLY

5. **Electronics or Hazardous Waste**
Batteries, paint, electronics are not allowed in any container
→ NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CONTAINER
