- ✓ Flatten cardboard boxes to create more room in your recycling barrel.
- Do not bag recyclable items.
- ✓ Utilize your bulky item pick-up services for e-waste and large items that do not fit in your trash barrel.
- ✓ No wipes down the pipes! Do not flush wipes or paper towels.
- ✓ Donate any unwanted items that are still in good condition. Remember that leaving donations outside of a closed center is illegal, and illegally dumped items could ultimately end up in the trash.



# **How to Safely Dispose of Sharps at HHW County Facilities**

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY RESIDENTS can safely dispose of their used SHARPS in a 2 gallon or smaller, heavy-duty, plastic container as an alternative to plastic bio-hazard sharps containers at participating Household Hazardous Waste Collection facilities. Containers should only contain needles, lancets, and syringes with a needle attached that must be completely spent (no liquid remaining, including EpiPens).

### **HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN CONTAINER:**

- Place sharps into an Approved Sharps Container or 2 gallon or smaller heavy-duty plastic container
- Do not use food product containers
- Must have a screw-top and puncture resistant lid
- Made of thick plastic
- 2 gallons or less
- Leak-resistant
- Remain upright when standing
- Place printed Bio-Hazard Label on both sides
- When 3/4 filled, secure lid, and tape the container closed


# CLEAN MOUNTAIN SITES DROP-OFF LOCATIONS FOR TRASH, RECYCLABLES AND GREEN WASTE

### ALL SITES REQUIRE YOUR MOST CURRENT TRASH BILL FOR PROOF OF SERVICE

The Burrtec Clean Mountain Sites are for residential properties subscribed to curbside or clean mountain service. The sites are open every weekend with the exception of Burrtec recognized holidays and Easter Sunday. For more information, contact Mountain Disposal at (909) 338-2417, Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Clean Mountain Sites may close during periods of inclement weather or if unsafe/hazardous conditions exist for the public and staff.

### **CLEAN MOUNTAIN SITES OPERATING GUIDELINES**

- All residential household trash brought to the site must be in a 32-gallon trash container. Limit of 5 cans per property, per day.
- Green waste must be in a 32-gallon trash container or bagged.
- Tree branches and limbs brought to the site cannot exceed 4-feet in length and must be tied in bundles no bigger than 2-feet in diameter.
- Unlimited green waste is accepted, per single family generator, as long as it's contained.
- You may bring **two** bulky items per day; this includes E-Waste.
- Renters and vacationers are required to bring a copy of a current invoice. Please reach out to the property owner or management team for more information.
- No trailer loads or loose materials will be taken. These items can be hauled off to Heaps Peak Transfer Station located at 29898 State Highway 18, Running Springs, CA 92382.
- Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is not accepted. HHW consists of items such as paint, motor oil, paint thinner, turpentine, pesticides and herbicides. For information regarding the disposal of HHW, call 1-800-OILY CAT
- No construction material or tires are accepted at any of the sites.
- Landscapers and third-party haulers are NOT allowed to use the drop off locations for any material types.
