Residential Food Waste Recycling Program Frequently Asked Questions

Am I required to participate?

Yes, this is a California law that requires all residents, multi-family tenants and commercial businesses to participate in food waste recycling to comply with Senate Bill 1383.

Will plastic bags be supplied?

Customers are required to provide their own bags and can reuse any plastic bag that will seal or tie closed. Bags do not need to be compostable or biodegradable.

What is the benefit of recycling food waste?

Your recycling efforts contribute to the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions from landfilled organic waste. This includes methane, a greenhouse gas 80 times more potent than carbon dioxide.

I already backyard compost, do I have to participate?

We encourage you to continue backyard composting. Organic items, such as poultry, beef and fish bones, typically not suitable for backyard compost can be recycled through this program.

Can I use my garbage disposal instead?

You may continue to use your garbage disposal for food waste. Food currently being discarded in your trash container should now be bagged and placed in your green waste container.

What items are acceptable?

Fruits, vegetables, meats, seafood, dairy, eggshells, bread, food scraps, food soiled paper, plate scrapings and expired food. Reference the container guide below or visit Burrtec.com or GreenSantaClarita.com for more details.

What items are not acceptable?

Trash, styrofoam, liquids, glass, plastic, metal, diapers, pet waste, electronic waste and hazardous waste.

Home Compost Bins

Burrtec will distribute up to 500 home compost bins per calendar year, to residents who wish to compost organic waste at home. The compost bins are only available to residential single family homes, upon request and while supplies last each year. Only available for residential single family homes. To request a home compost bin, please call our Customer Service department at (661) 222-2249. If you have recently requested a compost bin, it will be delivered in the next several weeks.

Senior/Low-Income Discount

If you are 60 years or older, you may qualify for a discount on your trash bill. Seniors who meet the following requirements should apply:

- 1. 60 years or older
- 2. Head of household
- 3. Must reside at the residence
- 4. The account must be in their name
- 5. A person of low, lower, or extremely low income, and enrolled in a discounted utility program If you meet these requirements contact the City of Santa Clarita Customer Service Department at (661) 222-2249 or visit Burrtec.com/SCV to download and print a discount application.

Free Bulky Item Collection

Santa Clarita residents with active trash service receive up to four (4) free bulky item pick-ups per year, with three (3) large items or ten (10) 32-gallon bags per pick-up. Please contact Burrtec Customer Service at (661) 222-2249 at least 48 hours in advance of your regular service day to schedule a bulky item pick-up.

Acceptable items include: furniture, appliances and mattresses. For the health and safety of our drivers, we ask that all mattresses be wrapped in plastic.

Non-acceptable items include: hazardous waste, machinery and industrial discards, electronic waste, oil, grease and other liquids, construction and demolition debris or excessively large items.

Holiday Schedule

Please note that services are interrupted on the following holidays:

Memorial Day Thanksgiving Day Independence Day Christmas Day

Labor Day New Year's Day

When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

Extra Holiday Waste

Approximately 80% of your holiday trash is recyclable. All gift boxes, wrapping paper, greeting cards and cardboard packaging are items that may be placed in your recycling bin. Burrtec will collect your excess holiday trash and recyclables. Beginning the day after Christmas for approximately one week, place excess holiday trash/recyclables in bags alongside your carts on your collection day.



The Holidays Are Soon **Approaching**

Burrtec will collect and recycle holiday trees from singlefamily residences. Please place your tree curbside after Christmas on your collection day. Burrtec will provide this service for approximately two weeks after Christmas Day. If possible, trees 6' and over should be cut in half. Please remove all ornaments, lights and metal stands. Flocked trees will not be recycled and will be collected as trash. Happy Holidays!



Dispose of Your Batteries and Other Hazardous Waste Responsibly

There are many household items that may seem non-toxic but are very harmful to the environment if not disposed of properly. Some common HHW items include batteries, paint, automotive fluids, lawn chemicals, household cleaners and electronic items. All of these items can be disposed of safely and for FREE at the next Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Waste collection event.

Sharps? What to do with them?

Home generated sharps, such as needles, syringes and lancets should be placed in a sharps container and removed from the regular waste stream to minimize exposure to workers and processors.

To ensure sharps are handled in an appropriate manner, Burrtec will provide the following to each resident, upon request:

Residents:

• One postage paid mail-back sharps container per year at no additional cost.

Seniors:

• Two postage paid mail-back sharps container per year at no additional cost.
