Hot Ashes and Charcoal Disposal

One common cause for fires in trucks and containers is hot coals and ashes. Coals that appear to be cool can actually remain hot for days after use. Please allow 48 to 72 hours for charcoal and ashes to cool down before disposing of them in the trash container.



Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your garbage, organics and recycling carts in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. **DO NOT place carts on the curb or sidewalk.** Carts should have the handles facing towards your home and placed 1 foot apart from each other. Carts need to be placed at least 3 feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle. **To ensure your service is not missed, all carts must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.**
