Electronic Waste (E-waste)

Electronic waste may contain potentially toxic substances such as lead, copper, and other heavy metals. This is why they must be disposed of properly! Electronic waste, or e-waste, may include computers, monitors and televisions. Residents may place up to two e-waste items out with their bulky items for pickup. Please do not place e-waste in any of the barrels. Please Contact our Customer Service Department for more information.

Food Waste Recycling

California passed a law requiring organics recycling to improve air quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The state reports that landfilled organic waste (including food waste) decomposes in landfills and generates greenhouse gases contributing to global climate change.

Thank you for bagging your food waste and placing it inside your green organics barrel.

How to Recycle Food Waste at Home

- Collect-** Begin collecting food waste separate from your trash and recycling. This includes: fruits, vegetables, meats, seafood, bread, dairy, eggshells, coffee, plate scrapings, peels, rinds, and food soiled paper such as napkins and coffee filters.
- Add & Secure-** Collect food waste & food soiled paper in its own separate plastic bag. Store it in a convenient place, such as on your counter top, in your refrigerator or under your sink. Secure plastic bag by tying it off. Remember bags do not have to be compostable or biodegradable. They can be any color. We encourage you to re-use bags you may already have such as bread bags and produce bags.
- Discard-** Place your bagged food waste & food soiled paper into your green barrel. Continue using your green waste barrel for non-bagged landscape waste. Remember, food waste no longer belongs in your trash barrel.

When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

The Holidays Are Soon Approaching

Yucaipa Disposal will collect and recycle Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at curbside after Christmas on your collection day. Yucaipa Disposal will provide this service for approximately a 2 week period after Christmas Day. Trees 6 feet and over need to be cut in half. Please take all ornaments, lights, and metal stands off of the tree. Flocked trees will not be recycled. They will be collected as trash. Flocked trees 6 feet and over need to be cut in half.



Extra Holiday Waste

The holidays are approaching! Yucaipa Disposal will collect your excess holiday trash. Beginning the day after Christmas for approximately 1 week, place excess holiday trash in bags alongside your container(s) on your collection day.
