# CART FAQs

## WHEN WILL BURTEC START SERVICING MY CARTS?

Beginning July 1, 2023, Burrtec will be servicing all residential and commercial properties in the City.

## WHAT ARE THE NEW CART COLORS?

New cart colors are required under state legislation and will provide consistency across the industry – these cart colors include black for garbage, blue for recycling and green for organics. Discounts will be available for senior citizens and reduced size garbage cart users upon request.

## WHAT IF I WANT DIFFERENT SIZE CARTS?

You can contact Burrtec Customer Service to modify your carts sizes (or change your service level if a Multi-Family or Business) at any time.

## CAN I KEEP MY OLD CARTS FROM WASTE MANAGEMENT?

No, all old Waste Management carts and bins will be exchanged and replaced with new carts and bins from Burrtec.

## WILL MY SERVICE DAY CHANGE?

No, your service day will remain the same, however, you may experience a new pick-up time.

## WHAT SHOULD I DO ON SERVICE DAY?

Please place your carts out the night before your service day or no later than 6:00 a.m. on your service day. Place carts at the curb with the handles facing in. Avoid placing carts near objects that prevent collection such as vehicles, light poles, mailboxes, driveways, etc. Please do not block sidewalks. Do not overfill carts and be sure lids are securely closed. Do not place items on the ground next to carts or on top of the lid.

## WILL BURTEC STILL TAKE MY BULKY ITEMS FOR DISPOSAL?

Yes, effective July 1, 2023 Burrtec will take bulky items for free at their local facility and will schedule a free curbside pick up if contacted at least 48 hours prior to next collection day. Residents are allowed four bulky item pick-ups per year, with up to three items per pick-up.

## WHAT NEW SERVICES WILL BE INCLUDED WITH MY NEW ACCOUNT FROM BURTEC?

New services will include state-mandated organics recycling, carpet recycling, food waste pails, composting kits, extra cardboard collection, community document shredding events, move in and move out service, and a local customer service center to effectively handle local calls currently located at 26000 Springbrook Avenue Suite 101, Santa Clarita CA 91350.
