Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your garbage, organics and recycling carts in the street, at the curb or near the corner of your driveway. DO NOT place carts on the curb or sidewalk. Carts should have the handles facing towards your home and placed one foot apart from each other. Carts need to be placed at least three feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle. To ensure your service is not missed, all carts must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.





Pre-Pay Discount

Burrtec will provide a one-month discount to the total annual bill for all single-family customers that pre-pay their bill on an annual basis. Pay eleven (11) months before January 31st and receive the 12th month free!

Free Bulky Item Collection

Santa Clarita residents with active trash service receive up to four (4) free bulky item pick-ups per year. Please contact Burrtec Customer Service at (661) 222-2249 at least 48 hours in advance of your regular service day to schedule a bulky item pick-up. Electronic waste, or E-waste, can be recycled through bulky item drop-off, mobile collection event or SAFE Collection Center.

Acceptable items include: furniture, appliances and mattresses. For the health and safety of our drivers, we ask that all mattresses be wrapped in plastic.

Non-acceptable items include: hazardous waste, machinery and industrial discards, electronic waste, oil, grease and other liquids, construction and demolition debris or excessively large items.



Did You Know?

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes items like paint, pesticides and electronic waste. There are many other household items that may seem non-toxic but are very harmful to the environment if not disposed of properly. Items like pool chemicals, household cleaners, automotive fluids, medication and needles, beauty products, batteries and compact fluorescent light bulbs are all considered HHW items.

Top 5 Items to Keep OUT of Your Recycling Cart

Here are the 5 top items that should never be placed in your recycling cart:

- 1. No Garden Hoses. Despite being made from rubber, vinyl or a combination of both, this item belongs in the garbage container.
- 2. No Diapers. Diapers are not considered organics and are not recyclable. They belong in your black garbage container.
- 3. No Hazardous Waste. Paint, motor oil, batteries, syringes, needles, etc. are all considered Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). Hazardous Waste puts our trucks and facility at risk and should not be placed in your garbage cart either. Visit GreenSantaClarita.com for proper disposal options, mobile HHW and E-waste event information and collection center details.
- 4. No Flimsy Plastic. Flimsy plastic, like pet food bags, produce bags or regular plastic grocery store bags are not recyclable and belong in your black garbage container. Consider reusing closeable bags to collect food waste!
- 5. No Electronic Waste. Electronic waste, or E-waste, can be recycled through bulky item drop-off, mobile collection event or SAFE Collection Center.
